Dear guests, everything will be done to ensure that your stay meets your expectations.

The Hulottière is a family home however, there may be other guests staying here at the same time as you.

Our three guest rooms comply with the provisions of articles D324-13 and D324-14 of the Code of Tourism - to provide a bed for the night, breakfast, a supply of bed linen, towels and access to a bathroom and a wc.

Breakfast:

A continental breakfast is served at 9.00h either in the dining room or weather permitting on the terrace. If you require an earlier breakfast, please let us know in advance.

The rooms:

Guests can access the free wi-fi with the following code.

Eating meals and laundering clothes in the bedrooms is prohibited.

If there is any spillage on the bed linen, towels etc, please let us know immediately so we can clean and change the items.

Although the rooms are secure, it is our guests responsibility to safeguard their valuables. Please don't leave jewellery, multimedia devices or bank cards in your room or car, as we cannot be held responsible for any items that go missing.

We ask guests to return to the house by 23.00h (unless by prior arrangement) as we lock the front door. This is to ensure other guests are not disturbed. We do not allow guests to have the front door key.

Check-out time is 11.00h.

Swimming pool

Guests can use the pool from 17-19h during the summer period, weather permitting. We can supply bathing towels if required.

General notes

Consumption of any meals in the room is not allowed.

Obviously there is strictly no smoking in the room. There is a space on the terrace for smokers.

The kitchen is private and not for use by guests, however we will store any small perishables in the fridge if required.

We respectfully ask that guests leave their room in a tidy condition when they depart.
